We've all heard the debate: does communism inhibit church growth? For Cuba—after nearly 60 years under a communist government—the answer is a resounding NO. Believers in Cuba remained resilient through the difficult early years of the Revolution under the atheistic-leaning philosophy of Fidel Castro. Over the last two decades they have enjoyed more religious freedom and church growth has accelerated!

Just 90 miles south of Key West, Florida, Cuba is the largest island in the Caribbean. It is part paradise and part prohibiting. The churches of Cuba continue to face some limitations, yet their numbers keep multiplying in house churches and small groups. This growth necessitates biblical training that leads to healthy discipleship. This is the reason why Gateway Missions feels compelled to GO train, encourage and equip the pastors and church leaders who are risking everything for the sake of the Gospel.
