In 2012 nine men from our home church, Church on the Rock/Pursue Missions, packed up and went to San Francisco, Brazil to build a church in the Amazon. Since then that entire village has received Christ as their savior and are reaching their surrounding villages with the good news of Jesus Christ! Now five years later, (June 24-July 1) we are taking another team of 11 men back to the Amazon to build another church and evangelize the village of Chimbote, Peru. We will be working alongside Leo Grisales with JUMP Ministries and Jaime Useche with Amazon Ministries

International. No two trips are ever the same, however our God never changes and we know He will be magnified in the lives of the Peruvian

villagers in Chimbote. Chimbote was established in 1822 as a small fishing village in the Amazon Rainforest of Peru. Our accommodations will be tents, no fresh water and no electricity! Our team will take a three hour riverboat ride from the southern part of Colombia to our destination in Peru. We are eager to experience the plans and miracles that God has in store for us this year.



Boat Loads of Blessings

We are extremely grateful to **Pursue Missions** for giving Gateway Missions a grant to purchase two Amazon River Boats (above) and Motors which will be given to two Amazon pastors (right) that we met last year at our Pastors Conference in Medellin, Colombia. These two pastors and their families are very deserving. In addition they will be able to have their wives and children travel with them which will strengthen family relationships and reduce the sense of neglect while ministering away from home.

Medellin the Pearl of Colombia

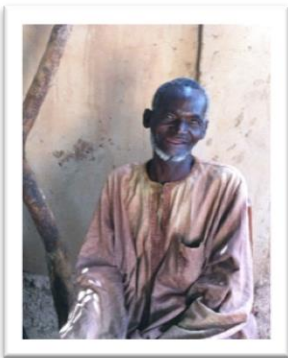


Two weeks after we return from the Amazon mission, we will take another ministry team of 19 people to Medellin (July 15-22) which is the second largest city in Colombia. Medellin was the epicenter of the Western Hemisphere's 52 years of drug wars. Drug-related violence has had a devastating effect on the citizens of Colombia and Medellin in particular. Just 10 years ago Medellin was known as the Killing Capital of the World. But now Medellin is experiencing a tremendous

move of God! There is a great need for the gospel to be preached. Where decades of indescribable violence and corruption once reigned, people now have hope. Vast numbers of people are being healed, set free from demonic strongholds and being saved daily! That is why Gateway Missions is focusing so much of our time, resources and energy there. Central and South America are flashpoints for the proclamation of Jesus and we believe it is imperative to strike while the iron is hot.

Jane Ann and I are often asked why we do what we do. The short answer is because we believe what God has done in and for us, He will do for others.
