The first challenge was the rain and the second was a nationwide strike of Tanzania's transit system. In that region many people travel by foot or public transit buses. On first day the attendance was not as many as we expected, but we were not discouraged. Instead we saw it as an opportunity to give everything we had no matter what. Christ was going to be lifted up and honored if only one person was present. Thankfully the weather cleared, but the strike continued and so did our teaching and preaching. In all we had 485 pastors and church leaders in attendance. That was indeed a miracle!
