The beautiful country of Colombia, known for its tropical landscapes, was the epicenter of the Western Hemisphere's drug wars from the early 1980s until about six years ago. In the years since then, attention shifted to the carnage in Mexico, while drug-related violence in Colombia subsided. The aftermath of those ferocious days has left lives shattered and desperate. What you may not know is that NOW there is an EXPLOSION of the **Holy Spirit** bringing true revival to the cities and villages of Colombia! The people of Colombia are very compassionate and caring. Our team of fifteen was overwhelmed by the beauty of the people and the love they expressed toward us. We ministered in the streets to the homeless, loved on children at day care centers, preached in churches and meetings, conducted a Pastors and Church Leaders Conference for men and women and prayed with over 2,000 people individually in our seven days there.

CHILDREN & MOTHERS

Monday and Tuesday we visited two day care centers, called foundations, where we told bible stories, gave gifts to and played with 350 children ranging from age six months to early teens.



Our ladies team brought encouragement to 35 women from the local neighborhood where drugs and prostitution are widespread. Most of them face very difficult living conditions with poverty and abusive home relationships. After our team shared the Word and their testimonies, we prayed for each of the women. Many of them were healed spiritually and emotionally from broken hearts and despairing spirits. The Holy Spirit brought hope! One lady shared (through a translator) a line from a poem she wrote for us: *"In this beautiful day something is going to change in this group of ladies that got the victory!"*



FEEDING THE HOMELESS



Feeding the homeless was a very interesting time. Being with the forgotten people who live on the streets or tent villages made me think of Matthew 9:36. *“When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.”* JUMP Ministries along with other ministries feeds and shares the love of Christ with them. It was moving to see how humble and grateful these people were that someone cared enough to ask their name and speak blessing and peace over them.
