In June we will be co-leading a Pursue Missions trip to the Amazon where we will build a church on the Peruvian side of the river. In 2012 we constructed our first church in San Francisco, Brazil. Since that time the entire village has come to Christ and has been evangelizing the surrounding villages. Also, Gateway Missions had a water recovery system installed to provide fresh water for the people. The church is now sharing that water with neighboring villages in order to reach them with the good news of Christ! Our 12 man team is ready to let God use us to build His Kingdom! During the day we will do construction work and at night conduct evangelistic services. Our team will also do visitation and have prayer times with the people in the village.

MEDELLIN COLOMBIA



Gateway Missions will be leading a team back to Medellin in July. We will do outreach ministry in the local communities during the day and speaking in churches in the evenings. Our last day there will be spent training and encouraging 100 pastors and church leaders from all over the city. This will be the third time for us to co-op with Pursue Missions to lead a team in Medellin. The Holy Spirit is moving in an unprecedented way drawing people to make decisions for Christ. We have 19 people ready to put boots on the ground to bring the Kingdom of God to the beautiful people of Colombia!

PASTORS OF THE AMAZON



Thank you to Pursue Missions/Church on the Rock for providing the resources to purchase two boats for the pastors (pictured on the left) who attended our conference last year in Medellin. These two men travel up and down the river ministering in villages along the banks of the Amazon. The boats will help them in two ways. First, the boats will provide a

safe, dependable way to navigate the river. Secondly, the boats are large enough to allow the pastors' families to travel with them. Long trips going from village to village are very difficult for the families because the pastors are gone for extended periods of time.
