July 12, 2021

"Thousands of Cubans took to the streets on Sunday to protest a lack of food, medicine and fuel as the country undergoes a grave economic crisis aggravated by the Covid-19 pandemic. Their cries are "Down with Dictatorship" as they demonstrate against the

Communist Regime of 62 years and fight for their freedom!

Although we have not had the ability to travel to Cuba for over 18 months due to COVID-19 restrictions, we make it a priority to keep in touch with the pastors and church leaders there to encourage them and strengthen them. Gateway Missions has aided some of them with financial resources so they can purchase food, gas, clothing and medicine. We continue to pray for ways to help our friends and ministry partners there. Communications are limited due to the government control of television, internet and social media. We also just heard that Elon Musk (Tesla Motors) is working on a "back door" to make satellite access available so Cubans can connect to internet and stay in contact with the rest of the world! Thank you for your prayers and participation with this ministry. Your impact on these lives and many others has a global and eternal harvest. We hold the people of Cuba in our hearts and in our prayers.
