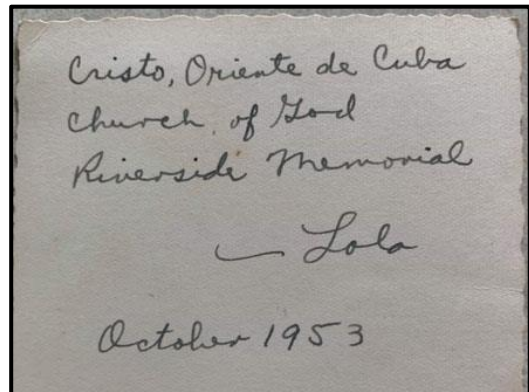
Cuba 2020

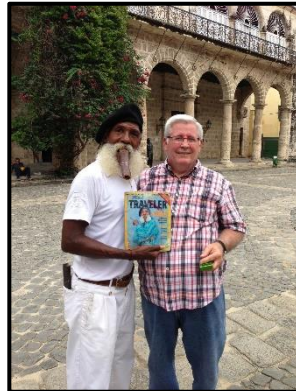
