As Gary and I see the horrific images of Russia's unprovoked invasion into Ukraine, we pray for the people and reflect on our trips over the years to Eastern Europe. This war is not only a threat to Ukrainians, but to the people of surrounding nations and to the very existence of the Church overall. The churches and the men and women who pastor them are strong and resilient. They are fully committed to the Gospel and to seeing a great harvest of souls for the Kingdom of God. Gateway Missions has ministered extensively in Russia, Ukraine, Transnistria and Moldova beginning in 1993, so we have a great regard and concern for the courageous people we have worked with and supported. Below are listed just a few ways that one church we work with is reaching people and providing for their spiritual and physical needs. Because of the sensitive nature of their location, we have been asked not to share their names or photos.

- Building new facilities that are compliant and up to date on recent pandemic regulations.
- Christmas Outreaches 101 events in 21 days.
- Ministered to 5,700 adults and children.
- Teen and Youth classes and events happening every day of the week.
- Expanded to four Sunday Worship services.
- Started food and wood distributions to needy families in surrounding villages.
- Providing assistance with food and housing to the influx of Ukrainian refugees.

God will not be deterred by pandemic or war. He is STILL on the throne and is STILL on the move. While we have not been able to be present physically with our key leaders in the last couple of years, we continue to send encouragement, financial support, and ministry via ZOOM to them. It is an honor to represent you in the nations.

## **MUHORRO, UGANDA**



Recently Paul Henry, Royce Riggin and I met via ZOOM with three of our key pastors in Uganda. These pastors have been enormously blessed and challenged as God has stretched them to expand their hearts' desires. They have taken great steps of obedience toward fulfilling their vision.

Because the necessity to train, encourage and empower indigenous pastors remains so great, Gateway Missions is increasing our online networking. This will provide us the ability to maintain current relationships and the opportunity to develop our global missions presence.
